Fiscal Analysis

From the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services (DHS) in Enrolled House Bill 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature:

- \$7,762,004 is to be used to replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching dollars.
- DHS is to maintain the funding levels for senior nutrition programs from FY-25.
- \$2,500,000 is to be used to make the second meal per day permanent for the ADvantage Waiver Program.
- DHS is to maintain funding levels for provider rates and service authorizations for the Community, Homeward Bound, In-Home Supports Waiver for Adults, In-Home Supports Waiver for Children, and ADvantage Waivers from FY-25.
- Transfer \$5,600,000 to the credit of the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account.
- All federal funds received by the state during FY-26 from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Block Grant be used to meet the provisions of federal law relating to such grants.
