**Fiscal Analysis**

From the funds appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) in Enrolled House Bill 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature:

- \$10,812,408 is to be used to replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching dollars.
- \$9,480,421 is to be used to meet the obligations required in the consent decree.
- \$18,500,000 is to be used for the continuum of care for children in crisis.
- \$1,300,000 is to be used to maintain services for veterans and their families.
