Research Analysis

The Committee Substitute to SB 1155 directs the apportionment of general appropriations to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The measure directs that \$500,000.00 be used to support the Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance Program. \$100,000.00 be used to support an Oklahoma-based nonprofit in order to preserve sports heritage and pride in Oklahoma. \$198,660.00 be used for community action agencies to support Head Start programs.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to SB 1155 is the Oklahoma Department of Commerce limits bill, which delineates the following items:

- \$500,000 in support to the Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance Program
- \$100,000 in support to an Oklahoma-based nonprofit to preserve sports heritage and pride
- \$198,660 in support of Head Start programs utilized by community action agencies.

Therefore, the total fiscal impact of this measure on state budgetary resources is Seven Hundred Ninety-eight Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$798,660.00).
