## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute creates the Oklahoma Secure Roads and Safe Trucking Act of 2025. The measure provides that a non-domiciled commercial driver license or non-domiciled commercial learner's permit issued by any other state shall not be considered valid authorization to operate a commercial motor vehicle in Oklahoma. Any person operating a commercial motor vehicle must possess a valid commercial driver license from the United States, Canada or Mexico and a valid work visa and proof of citizenship of the country that issued the license. The measure prohibits the holders of a B-1, B-2, or B-1/B-2 nonimmigrant visitor visa from operating a commercial motor vehicle. The measure provides a penalty of up to \$2,000 for violations. The measure requires an operator of a commercial motor vehicle to demonstrate sufficient proficiency of the English language.
