Research Analysis

CCR A for SB 287 rejects the House amendments to engrossed SB287, which would have also extended the aerospace tax credits to qualified higher education employees that work within a research institute dedicated to aerospace research.

As amended, SB287 extends the sunset date of the aerospace engineers and employers tax credits through tax year 2031.

The CCR removes the expansion of the definitions of *qualified employer* and *qualified employee*.

SB287 extends the sunset date of the aerospace engineers and employers tax credit through tax year 2032.
