**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 351 requires any seller imposing a surcharge for using a credit or debit card to list the fee on a separate line of the receipt. The surcharge cannot exceed the total of the bank processing fees, financial transaction fees, cost of providing secure transaction, portal fees, and fees necessary to compensate for increased bandwidth incurred as a result of the transaction.
