## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB375 allows officers of the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to police and set speed limits on roads located on lands owned by a state beneficiary public trust if the trust has entered into an interlocal agreement with the Commissioner of Public Safety to allow DPS to police these roads. The measure also allow a state beneficiary public trust to pass a resolution to restrict public use of its roadway if the roadway is not located within the boundaries of a municipality and are not designated for public use.
