## **Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 403 allows county purchasing agents to select the next lowest and best bidder from the list of qualified bidders if the original bidder is unable to provide service. Bidders will be considered at or below the amount they originally bid. Additionally, the measure exempts information technology, telecommunication goods, and certain professional services from county purchasing and procurement requirements.
