Research Analysis

SB 410 allows a computer science course, or the completion of year-long, full-time, three-hour CareerTech program leading to an industry credential or college credit, to fulfill a science requirement for high school graduation.

The measure also requires all students to take a computer science course to graduate, starting with the students entering the eighth grade in the 2026-2027 school year.

Lastly, the measure requires the State Board of Education to ensure computer science standards include instruction on Artificial Intelligence.
