Research Analysis

The floor amendment to SB 462 clarifies that a retired officer may be allowed to retain custody of their firearm and badge so long as the person has not been convicted of a felony.

Fiscal Analysis

The Engrossed version of SB462 would authorize municipal police officers to request for permission to retain their firearm and badge upon retirement. In its current form, this measure is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.

The FA1 expands the scope of officer exclusions under this measure, revising the criteria from precluding those convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude to now precluding all officers convicted of any felony.
