Fiscal Analysis

SB 563 permits county employees to receive up to three days of paid administrative leave for precinct official, absentee voting board member, or other election worker duties. Pursuant to the measure, such administrative leave may be utilized by county employees when the board of county commissioners develops such policy in accordance with the secretary of the county election board. The measure deals exclusively with county level policy regarding paid administrative leave and does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
