## **Research Analysis**

SB 574 authorizes the Attorney General to utilize the Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants as authorized by opioid-related settlement agreements in which the State of Oklahoma is a litigant or participant. The measure provides that the Attorney General may use up to 10% of the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Revolving Fund for statewide opioid abatement projects subject to approval by the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The Engrossed version of SB574 authorizes the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) to utilize Political Subdivisions Opioid Abatement Grants, and limites certain use of the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Revolving Fund monies. According to officials with the OAG, the agency already staffs the Opioid Abatement Board and manages the grant program on its behalf and the changes in the measure do not require any additional resources from the agency. Therefore, in its current form, SB574 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
