**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 68 adds the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the District Attorneys Council, the Office of the Attorney General, and the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector to the definition of *state agency* as it relates to the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act. The measure also establishes that state agencies, including those added to the definition, may employ information technology personnel to develop and implement the agency's technology strategy. Before hiring information technology personnel, the state agency must enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Chief Information Officer of the state to ensure data integrity and security.
