**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB 730 directs the Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics to develop and adopt a five-year Airport Construction Program on an annual basis. The Program must list federal and state funding that the Department has available for the development of airport infrastructure. The Department is also directed to adopt a statewide airport system plan, which must detail a twenty-year plan for publicly-owned, public-use airports and sets the service level, role, and functional classification of airports within the Oklahoma Airport System. An airport must be included in the system plan be eligible for funding.
