Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 745 extends the cut-off age for completing high school from 26 to 30. Anyone over the age 21 who is completing their high school diploma is required to do so through a virtual program offered by their district. Lastly, the measure excludes such individuals from being included in the calculation of a school's A-F report card and chronic absenteeism data.
