**Research Analysis**

The engrossed version of SB 774 amends the method to validate the authenticity of the medical marijuana patient license to require the authority to make available the twelve-character identification number, previously twenty-four characters, and the PDF417 barcode. This identification method will be used by dispensaries to verify patient licenses. The measure adds that this act will be in force for any new or replacement patient licenses issued after the act's effective date.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 774 modifies the medical marijuana patient license by reducing the identification number from twenty-four characters to twelve and includes a standard barcode for verification. The proposed changes are not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
