**Research Analysis**

SB 799 modifies statute regarding digital communication between students and school personnel. The measure allows homeless students to include an alternative adult in their electronic communication with school staff in lieu of a parent or guardian. The alternative adult must be the public school's McKinney-Vento homeless liaison, a case manager, or designated employee of the student's living program.
