## **Research Analysis**

SB 813 requires a peace officer making a preliminary investigation for an emergency protective order to make every attempt to serve the subject of the order and complete a return of service when filing the petition with the district court. The peace officer must file the petition with the district court the next business day if the officer cannot obtain service. The measure also requires the court clerk to document the date and time for the hearing and provide the information to the officer. The officer must provide the victim and subject of the order with a copy of the completed order.

The measure repeals <u>Title 21</u>, <u>Section 1173.1</u> relating to the stalking warning letter form.
