**Research Analysis**

SB 91 requires the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to complete a water quality study of the Spring Creek Watershed in Cherokee, Delaware, and Mayes counties. The study must find ways to improve the health of the watershed's aquatic habitats. The Commission is required to work with an advisory group, in addition to a technical advisory group, both created in the measure.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Engrossed SB 91 authorizes the Conservation Commission to conduct a water quality study of the Spring Creek Watershed and provide a report of their findings. The Conservation Commission estimates that the cost to conduct the study would be Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), but the agency is not requesting any additional appropriations to cover this cost as funding will be sourced from federal dollars. Therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal impact on state appropriations.
