Research Analysis

The Proposed Committee Substitute to SB 91 modifies the qualifications of the Executive Director of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by removing the requirement that the a person must possess a bachelor degree in law enforcement. The measure requires the appointee to possess a minimum of ten years of experience in the field of law enforcement as a supervisor or minimum of five years of experience in law enforcement and a degree from a four-year college in law enforcement administration, law, criminology, or a related science.
