Research Analysis

SB 921 clarifies that a person participating in the IDAP program will not be subject to revocation if the Board of Tests for Alcohol and Drug Influence receives the request for IDAP participation and payment of the program fees within 30 calendar days from the date of the receipt of the revocation notice from Service Oklahoma.

The Floor Substitute adds Title 47, Section 753 to address the refusal of chemical tests subject to revocation by Service Oklahoma. The Floor Substitute also adds an emergency clause.

Fiscal Analysis

The floor substitute to SB 921 adds an emergency clause and adds pertinent language regarding the refusal of certain blood, breath, saliva, or urine samples.
