Research Analysis

SB 940 requires the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to implement a plan for the control, removal, and eradication of harmful and invasive plants on state-owned and operated lands. Various state agencies are required to compile and present a report detailing the affected inventory and subsequent plan to control or remove such species no later than January 1, 2026. Such agencies shall submit a report to the Legislature no later than November 1, 2026, and each year thereafter detailing the progress on such control and removal.

Fiscal Analysis

Engrossed SB 940 requires the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to implement a statewide plan targeting harmful woody species on state lands. This plan relies on reports submitted by various state agencies submitted to the Conservation Commission. Per the Conservation Commission, this measure is not anticipated to have any fiscal impact to FY-26 state budgetary resources; however, implementation of the statewide plan may require additional resources in future fiscal years.
