Research Analysis

The floor amendment for SB 96 makes it unlawful for any person to manufacture, sell, hold or offer for sale, or distribute any cultivated meat product in the state. Violations will be guilty, upon conviction, of a misdemeanor. A seller for food that sells or distributes cultivated meat products in violation of this section will be subject to all enforcement measure provided by the State Department of Health and their license may be suspended or revoked. The State Department of Health may adopt rules to implement as necessary. Nothing in this section will be construed as preventing entities from conducting research regarding the production of cultivated meat products.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM ENGROSSED VERSION:

The floor amendment deals with a similar topic, but changes the bill from amended language to all new language.

Fiscal Analysis

The floor amendment to SB 96 prohibits the manufacture or sale of any cultivated meat in the state. The measure allows the State Department of Health to adopt rules regarding the suspension or revocation of a food seller license upon conviction of a violation of this prohibition.
