Bill Analysis

HB 1087 directs school districts to be in session and offer classroom instruction for an additional day at the beginning of each state fiscal year in which the amount appropriated for the financial support of public schools is at least \$25 million greater than the amount appropriated for the prior fiscal year. The bill also extends the minimum salary schedule for certified personnel from 25 years to 40 years of experience. It removes outdated language regarding salary increases for the 2022-2023 school year. It also removes language directing funds to be allocated to implement salary increases in school districts that do not receive Foundation Aid or Salary Incentive Aid.
