## **Bill Analysis**

HB 1224 strikes language prohibiting a health care professional providing services to a minor who is found not to be pregnant nor suffering from a communicable disease nor drug or substance abuse from disclosing medical information to the spouse, parent or legal guardian, without the consent of the minor. The measure also provides that the parents or legal guardians of the minor shall have the right to access medical information pertaining to the minor unless such access is otherwise prohibited by law, the parent or guardian is subject the subject of an investigation of a crime committed against the minor child, the minor is married or emancipated, the minor is separated and not supported by his or her parent or guardian, or the minor is physical incapacitated and married or has no such parent or guardian.
