**Bill Analysis**

HB 1356 requires any individual entering through gates used for ingress or egress to a property designated as an easement to maintain the position of the gate upon use. Any person found to violate this requirement shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a maximum fine of \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the county jail for no more than 90 days. The maximum fine and maximum term of imprisonment is doubled for a second offense. The maximum fine is increased to \$1,500.00 and the maximum term of imprisonment is increased to 1 year for third and subsequent offenses.
