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Bill Analysis

HB 1414 requires any person filing to run for the office of county sheriff to present proof of police qualification at the time of filing with the secretary of the county election board. The measure authorizes the Secretary of the State Election Board to prescribe a form to be included as part of the documented proof of police or veteran experience. The measure provides that persons who served as military police may count 4 or more years of service to meet the experience qualifications using a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) when filing to run for office.

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
