Bill Analysis

HB 1575 directs the Department of Human Services to conduct a feasibility study on the potential establishment of a unified and streamlined eligibility and enrollment system for public assistance programs. The system shall include the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program, child care subsidies, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), the state Medicaid program, and the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) program. The Department shall issue a request for information on the program for potential vendors. The Department, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, and the State Department of Health shall coordinate to conduct the feasibility study. The Department shall submit a report on the conclusions of the study to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, and the Governor.
