Bill Analysis

HB 1628 caps the fee the Construction Industries Board may levy on any person who violates any of the provisions of the commercial roofer endorsement standards of the Roofing Contractor Registration Act at \$500.00 for the first violation and \$1,000.00 for the second violation. The measure directs the Board to administer and enforce the residential roofer endorsement provisions of the Act. Such administration shall include establishing continuing education requirements, establishing minimum standards of residential roofer endorsements, issuing or denying endorsements to engage in residential roofing, conducting investigations, levying fines, conducting disciplinary proceedings, and requesting prosecutions against certain violators. The measure requires each residential roofing contractor to receive a residential roofing endorsement prior to providing such services. Applicants shall be required to pass an exam and complete 10 hours of continuing education.
