Bill Analysis

HB 1664 authorizes county commissioners to attend conferences, trainings, and educational, press, proceeding of the Legislature, and social events even if a quorum is present. No official action may be taken at such events and any discussion of county business shall be incidental. County commissioners are authorized to discuss budgetary matters at county budget board meetings provided no official action is taken. The measure also authorizes the Statewide Independent Living Council to conduct executive sessions using videoconference technology. No Council member shall be required to be physically present as long as each Council member is audible or visible to each other. The meeting notice shall indicate if the executive session will include videoconferencing and shall also state the identity of each Council member appearing remotely.
