Bill Analysis

HB 1789 provides that areas within municipal, county, or state-owned or controlled facilities or within the grounds of any county, district, or state fair shall be exempt from manufacturer-designated areas of sales responsibility for the purposes of sponsored off-premises sales events. A recreational vehicle dealer promoting its own private off-premises sales event where that dealer is the sole participating dealer shall not conduct sales activities outside of its manufacturer designated area of sales responsibility. The measure provides that a dealer participating in a sponsored off-premises sales show shall not be denied a permit on the grounds that the promotion is to be held within the relevant market area of another dealer of the same-line make. Dealers and sponsoring entities must obtain permission from the manufacturer to participate in a private recreational vehicle show.
