Bill Analysis

HB 2262 requires any referral agency disclosing certain documentation to a patient or representative of a patient with Alzheimer's to provide notice that the representative is entitled to request from the unit, program, or facility the disclosure form for each facility the referral agency recommends. The measure also requires any facility that offers specialized memory or dementia care to post a poster in a conspicuous location stating that if patients or their representatives were not given a copy of the disclosure form, they may file a complaint with the Consumer Protection Unit of the Office of the Attorney General.
