Bill Analysis

HB 2302 designates certain parking spaces on the Oklahoma State Capitol grounds to be assigned by the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The measure also reserves the southernmost row of parking spaces in the south parking lot for the Department of Public Safety to create a large vehicle inspection station. The measure requires the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to maintain all streets, roads, and state-owned parking lots within the boundaries of the State Capitol Park as well as provide signage as assigned or designated by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor.
