Bill Analysis

HB 2756 creates the High Voltage Electric Transmission Facility Act. The measure requires transmission developers to file an application to obtain a certificate of authority from the Corporation Commission for each electric transmission facility. The application shall include the contact information for the developer, a description and a map or plat of the proposed route or routes or alternative route or routes for the facility, identification of counties within the facility's route, identification of energy resources to which the electric transmission facility is to be directly connected, and an estimate of the costs to any Oklahoma electric customers and the estimated time frame for the electric transmission facility being developed. Any documents filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) shall also be forwarded to the Commission within 10 days of filing with FERC. Prior to the hearing to determine whether the facility receives certification, the applicant shall notify the entities listed in the measure. The Commission shall issue a certificate of authority if the applicant meets the requirements listed in the measure. The Commission may issue a maximum filing fee of \$1,000.00.
