Bill Analysis

SB 1002 provides that public funds shall not be granted to any entity that provides or refers patients to gender transition services. State employees violating this prohibition shall be subject to disciplinary action. The measure prohibits state owned facilities and health care providers employed by the state or a political subdivision from providing gender transition services. Such providers who violate this provision shall be subject to disciplinary action and shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Persons convicted of such a misdemeanor shall be subject to a \$1,000.00-\$10,000.00 fine and a term of imprisonment of 1 month-1 year.
