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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1013 authorizes a general contractor and a subcontractor to enter into a written agreement under which the general contractor provides workers' compensation insurance coverage to the subcontractor and employees of the subcontractor. The measure provides that if the subcontractor does not have employees, the subcontractor shall be treated as an employee of the contractor for the purposes of the Administrative Workers' Compensation Act. The measure designates premises owners as the employer of all subcontractors. The measure provides that premiums for the coverage shall be deducted from the contract price or other amount owed to the subcontractor by the general contractor. The measure specifies that workers for an oil or gas well operator shall not be entitled to such coverage.

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
