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Bill Analysis

SB 1039 provides for the denial of a medical marijuana business or patient license on the basis of improper completion of the application, unpaid license or application fees, or for a reason provided for in the provisions of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act. If an application is denied on the basis of incomplete information, the applicant may submit the required information within 30 days for reconsideration. The measure requires applicants and licensees to remit all required license and application fees in full within 45 days of notification by the Authority. Failure to remit such fees shall result in the denial of the application.

CCR Changes

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1039 removes the mandatory denial language from the engrossed version and adds language requiring applicants and licensees to remit all license and application fees within a certain period.

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
