**Bill Analysis**

SB 1151 appropriates funding to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund in the following manner:

- 1) \$2 million to provide water infrastructure funding to a rural water sewer and solid waste management district in the central region of the state experiencing private water well contamination from an unknown source and needing to be connected with a public water supply,
- 2) \$2 million to construct water lines in a county with a population greater than 150,000 and less than 200,000, and
- 3) \$200,000.00 to establish grant programs that facilitate the design, construction, and maintenance of water and wastewater infrastructure, and to improve the condition of publicly owned, deficient dams regulated by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board.
