**Bill Analysis**

SB 1169 directs the Long-Range Capital Planning Commission expend 20% of its allocated funds on 4-year colleges and universities receiving a Research Colleges and Universities designation from the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education. The measure directs 50% of this funding to those colleges and universities defined as a historically black college or university pursuant to the federal Higher Education Act of 1965 and 50% to other colleges and universities. Additionally, 35% of allocated funds shall be provided to 2-year institutions of higher education and 45% of allocated funds shall be expended on all 4-year colleges and universities except the University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma State University.
