**Bill Analysis**

SB 1202 provides full-time public school district employees, classroom instructional employees at technology center school districts, persons employed as teachers by the State Department of Rehabilitation Services, persons employed as correctional teachers or vocational instructors by the Department of Corrections, and persons employed as teachers by the Office of Juvenile Affairs 6 weeks of paid paternity leave following the birth of an employee's child or 6 weeks of paid adoption leave following the adoption of an employee's child. The measure changes the name of the Public School Paid Maternity Leave Revolving Fund to the Public School Paid Maternity, Paternity, and Adoption Leave Revolving Fund. It also changes the name of the Education Employee Paid Maternity Leave Revolving Fund to the Education Employee Paid Maternity, Paternity, and Adoption Leave Revolving Fund.
