Bill Analysis

SB 1206 provides that any member of the public may address a public body on any agenda item, item of new business, or any non-agenda item relevant to the function of the public body in the time designated for public comment at a meeting of the public body. The measure limits rules and policies relating to members of the public addressing a public body to providing guidelines to the amount of time a person may address the public body as well as designating the public comment period. Any official act to address an emergency situation or meeting not subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act shall not be subject to the requirements of this measure.
