Bill Analysis

SB 1207 directs the State Department of Education prior to the beginning of the 2027-28 school year to develop a curriculum to address awareness and prevention of domestic violence and human trafficking for 9th-12th graders. It allows the curriculum to be taught as a stand-alone unit or integrated into one or more existing courses. The bill allows school districts to begin teaching the curriculum in the 2027-2028 school year. It requires districts that provide the curriculum to provide an option for parents or legal guardians to opt out their students.
