**Bill Analysis**

SB 1213 strikes the requirement for an inmate to be incarcerated for a certain amount of time before earning credit for time served. The measure also specifies that inmates sentenced to serve time in the Department of Correction's custody shall earn 1.47 credits per day for each day incarcerated in a county jail beginning on the date of the judgment and sentence.
