Bill Analysis

SB 1222 prohibits any person holding a non-domiciled commercial driver license or non-domiciled commercial learner from operating a commercial motor vehicle within the state. The measure also specifies that any non-domiciled commercial driver license or non-domiciled commercial learner permit issued by another state shall be invalid. Persons found to have violated this provision shall be considered guilty of driving without a license and shall be prohibited from operating a commercial motor vehicle within this state until the driver is able to provide a valid commercial driver license or commercial learner permit.
