**Bill Analysis**

SB 1227 provides that when a mobile crisis team receives a request for assistance, it may request any safety-related information from a municipal or county law enforcement agency before responding to a request for assistance. The measure directs municipal and county law enforcement agencies to develop a protocol to ensure timely access to and delivery of safety-related information. Such disclosures shall be limited to reasonably necessary information to ensure the safety of the mobile crisis team. The measure clarifies that it does not require the disclosure of sealed or expunged records. The measure provides immunity to liability to any officer that discloses information in compliance with the provisions of the measure.
