**Bill Analysis**

SB 1230 directs Service Oklahoma to verify the lawful presence of an applicant of an original REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card. The measure directs Service Oklahoma to provide notary public services at no cost to the applicant. The lawful presence of the applicant shall be verified through the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or an equivalent program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security. Persons who have knowingly lied about their status shall be guilty of a felony. If the affidavit constitutes a false claim of U.S. citizenship, a complaint shall be filed by Service Oklahoma with the United States Attorney General for the applicable district based upon the venue in which the affidavit was executed.
