**Bill Analysis**

SB 1232 creates a felony offense for any person who enters any premises, easement, or right-of-way with intent to steal or remove any copper wire, copper cable, or copper tubing if such theft or removal results in damages equal to or exceeding \$100,000.00. Such persons shall be subject to a fine of up to \$50,000.00 and/or a term of imprisonment equal to penalty provisions of Class C2 felony offenses.
