Bill Analysis

SB 1241 creates the Oklahoma Fraud and Ticketing Accountability Act. The measure prohibits any person from using a bot to purchase tickets for any single Internet admission ticket sale. The measure further prohibits the use multiple IP addresses, purchaser accounts, or electronic mail addresses to exceed posted ticket limits and the circumvention of electronic queues, presale codes, sales volume limitations, security or access control measures. Primary ticket sellers must disclose the total price of the ticket, itemize all taxes and fees associated with the ticket, and the seat location on the ticket. The measure also implements various safeguards relating to the reselling of tickets and designates tickets as licenses. The measure directs the primary ticket seller, secondary ticket exchange, or reseller to issue a refund if an event is cancelled, the ticket is a counterfeit, the ticket location does not conform to the description of the ticket, or the ticket is not made available prior to the event. The measure prohibits ticket sellers from displaying the name, mark, logo, likeness, or intellectual property of an artist or venue without permission. Any violation of the provisions of this measure shall be considered an unfair or deceptive trade practice and shall be subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act.
