Bill Analysis

SB 1262 provides an undergraduate resident tuition waiver at institutions within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education and a tuition waiver at technology center schools for individuals who were victims of human trafficking for commercial sex or human trafficking for labor if the victims were under the age of 18 and a resident of this state when the offense occurred. It allows the waiver to be used for up to 5 years. It directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education to promulgate rules to implement the waiver including a process to verify eligibility with the Office of the Attorney General. The measure also amends the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Trust Fund to allow it to be used to cover the costs of tuition waivers provided to victims of human trafficking.
