**Bill Analysis**

SB 1266 increases the penalty as it relates to a notary public who holds himself or herself out as having expertise in providing legal advice on any proceeding, filing or action affecting the immigration or citizenship status of another person. The measure provides that such persons may also be sentenced to a maximum term of imprisonment of 1 year.
